Cincinnati, OH – Bill Burwinkel, chair of the Outreach Committee for Hamilton County Veterans Services, has been named the 2025 Ohio Vetrepreneur of the Year by Vetrepreneur Magazine.

According to Vetrepreneur.com, "this recognition celebrates outstanding veteran-owned business owners who epitomize inspiration through their exceptional commitment to entrepreneurship."

Bill served with the United States Army in Viet Nam. In 1970, he started a sales career following his military service. He is the chairman of the board for National Marketshare Group, which is a consumer products sales and marketing firm he founded in 1983.

As an ardent supporter of various community causes, Bill has received numerous community recognitions and awards. He founded Adopt A Class more than 20 years ago, a very successful non-profit organization that provides educational experiences throughout the school year for 7th graders in Greater Cincinnati.

One experience presented by Adopt A Class is Heroes Day. During this event, members of each branch of the military and law enforcement and fire professionals share information about and demonstrate career paths that students could pursue after high school.
